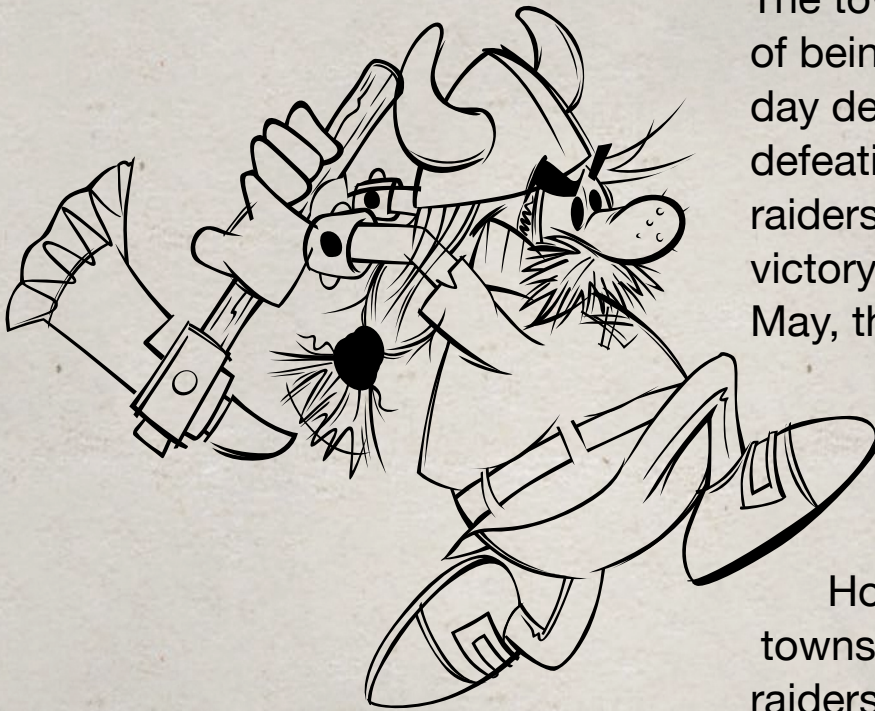


# Meet the Vikings of Llantwit Major
