STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

COPY

I, Colin Pearce, Forest District Manager of S E Wales Forest District, Wentwood, Llanvaches, Newport, Gwent on behalf of the Forestry Commission DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows

1 The Forestry Commission, 231 Colinton Road, Edinburgh EH12 7AT acquired the land shown on the attached maps, outlined in black in 1928. The land so delineated is currently in the ownership of the Forestry Commission

2 On 11th August 1997 I deposited map 19 of this document with Mr K Smith on behalf of Mr C Jones-Jenkins of Vale of Glamorgan County Borough Council being the appropriate Council, and state that no additional rights of way are dedicated on Forestry Commission land other than those rights of way marked as follows

*Brown* - which have been dedicated as highways with vehicular status,

*Green* - which have been dedicated as bridleways,

*Purple* - which have been dedicated as footpaths

3 No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged black on the plan accompanying this declaration other than those highways with vehicular status, bridleways and footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration. At the present time the Forestry Commission has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 16th day of September 1997 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.

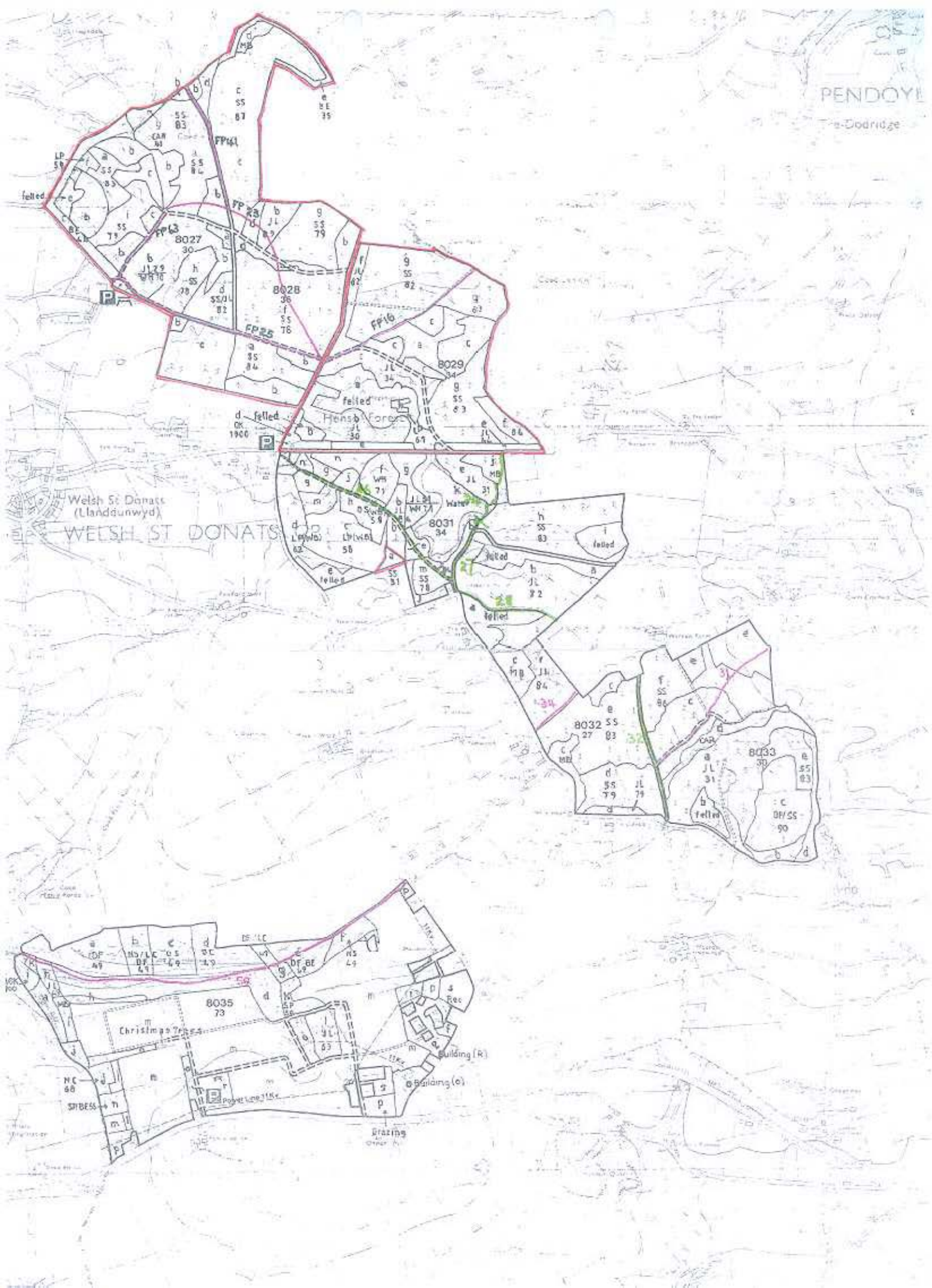
