# Conditions of Travel

- You must be a member to use the Greenlinks service except when Greenlinks operates a local bus service. To become a member you must be a resident of the Vale of Glamorgan.
- The cost will vary dependent on the distance travelled but will not be greater than £5.
   The new fare structure is set out below:

Charges for travel within or across number of zones	SINGLE	RETURN
1 Zone	£2	£3
2 Zones	£3	£4
3 Zones	£4	£5

The zones are East Vale. West Vale and External Vale.

- Please note 'External Vale' is limited to Porthcawl, Bridgend, Llantrisant (inc. Royal Glamorgan Hospital) and Cardiff. Please see diagram overleaf.
- Concessionary Bus Passes are not valid for use on the Greenlinks service except when Greenlinks operates as a local bus service (as advertised).
- Please telephone to request a journey as far in advance as possible. Requests must be made by I2 noon on the day prior to travel at the very latest. Requests on the day of travel will not be accepted. The phone line will be open from 9.00am to 1.00pm each day Monday to Friday.
