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
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
Space rocks - any type of ball, rolled up socks, balloons etc

Reggie is going to travel to the moon on a space rocket. Reggie makes his way to the space rocket and gets ready for take off







The rocket blasts off into Space, whizzing towards the moon and stars

Whilst flying to the moon, Reggie has to get his space suit on ready for landing.


The space suit is at the other end of the rocket, so Reggie has to crawl along the ship to get to it.

What types of objects can you push and move?






Reggie moves through the door and onto the surface of the moon.

Reggie has to get over there as quickly as possible to help them.


How would you move if you were in space?




Reggie makes friends with the alien and teaches them to play some games from Earth.

Reggie and his Alien friend finish playing as Reggie has to return to Earth. Reggie gets back on his space rocket and flies back to Earth just in time for his Tea.






