Alarm & Mobile Warden Service Eligibility Criteria for Supporting People funding

Alarms

Over 60 years old

At risk of a slip, trip or fall

Under 60 years old

People who are disabled or have a disabling illness (as evidenced by receipt of Personal Independence Payments, Disability Living Allowance, or Attendance Allowance; or medical evidence for those not yet in receipt of benefits claimed)

and at risk of a slip, trip or a fall.

At Risk of Domestic Abuse

Following the completion of a CAADA / DASH checklist IDVA and client have identified an alarm will reduce a risk or the perceived risk to the individual.

Mobile Warden Service (Cardiff Only)

In receipt of Housing Benefit or Council Tax Reduction

And one of the following:

• Over 80 years old and at risk of slips, trips and falls

or

• Significant Mobility issues (as evidenced by receipt of relevant disability benefit *)

or

 An illness that may result in slips trips and falls (confirmed by medical practitioner or Occupational Therapist)

* Mobility PIP or Mobility DLA

• The criteria will apply to all new clients from 1st October 2018

Existing Clients

• There will be no change to the service for existing clients
