Executive Summary:

1. Background

- 1.1 The Cabinet Quarterly Work Programme for April to June 2021 (Appendix 1) and July to September 2021 (Appendix 2) set out matters that are included in the Strategic Work Programme as well as other specific items that the Executive and Council are planning to consider during the period up to September 2021.
- 1.2 In accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Council's Constitution, the Cabinet Annual Strategic Forward Work Programme sets out matters which the Executive and Council are likely to consider during the period May 2021 to April 2022.
