




Fire Authority Budget History







Pay Inflation

2022/23 2023/24 2021/22 Two year's **Overspend currently** pay inflation projected at £1m but could could be a be up to £3m from underfurther 10% provision for pay inflation on the pay bill **Budget Underspend £3.8m** partly as a result of Strategy to fund this over-provision for pay year's overspend inflation from last year's underspend to avoid passing costs back to Councils in 2022/23






Vale of Glamorgan Operational Incidents












Vale of Glamorgan Fires Attended









All Fatalities from Fires



Vale of Glamorgan Fatalities from Fires













Vale of Glamorgan Injuries from Fires




