## **1. Background**

- 1.1 The Governance and Audit Committee's Forward Work Programme assists the Committee in ensuring that due consideration is given to all aspects of their core functions as set out in their Terms of Reference within the Council's Constitution.
- 1.2 Items feed into the Committee's Forward Work Programme from a number of sources. Many items are standard every quarter, six monthly or annually, and Members can also suggest topics for review by the Committee. Items can also be referred by the Cabinet, Scrutiny Committees or Chief Officers.
- 1.3 Effective Governance and Audit Committees help to raise the profile of governance, internal control, risk management and financial reporting issues within an organisation, as well as providing a forum for the discussion of issues raised by internal and external auditors. They enhance public trust and confidence in the financial governance of an authority.

## **2. Key Issues for Consideration**

- 2.1 To assist the Committee in ensuring that due consideration is given to all aspects of their core functions the proposed updated Forward Work Programme for 2023/24 is attached at **Appendix A**.
- 2.2 This has been amended to reflect the changes made in previous meetings, for example the Governance and Audit Committee Annual Report has been included as an annual item.
- 2.3 The Governance and Audit Committee Self-Assessment item has been moved to the next meeting; this will provide time to analyse the completed questionnaires received from members of this Committee. In addition, an Internal Audit Progress Report item will be presented to the next meeting, this will provide members of

the Committee with a provisional final position of audits completed against the 2023/24 audit plan.
