a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

We will operate with 3 SIA approved employees on site from 22:00 until close of business on Fridays, Saturdays and over any seasonal variations with a view to minimizing any impact the changes we wish to make. We will also install a CCTV system in order to properly any police any incidents.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
We intend to maintain our current rigorous efforts to prevent any crime and disorder, including being the chairman of Pubwatch Penarth (and Dinas Powys) and having more staff trained in conflict management.
c) Public safety
With extra staff we will ensure that we have more staff who are first aid trained to help any customers who are having any difficulties. Also with more staff we will be better able to police anyone attempting to take glass vessels outside reducing risks from that aspect. Also having SIA trained staff walking through the premises on occasion as well as being outside we should be able to see any negative situations arise earlier than we would currently.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
All windows and doors will be kept closed other than for people entering and exiting the premises to manage any noise pollution. Also by having SIA qualified staff on the premises we will be able to better manage any noise created by people leaving the premises. We will also provide more information to customers to respect our neighbours as they vacate the premises.
e) The protection of children from harm
We operate a challenge 25 policy at the bar at all times, the addition of 2 SIA trained staff will mean we can be even more vigilant, operating this policy not only inside the premises but before entry too.
