- The report provides an update on the progress of the Capital Programme for the period 1st April to 30th November 2021. Details by scheme are shown in Appendix 1.
- The report sets out any requested changes to the 2021/22 and future years Capital Programme.

1. Background

1.1 Council on 10th March 2021 (minute no 471) approved the Capital Programme for 2021/22 onwards.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

- **2.1** Appendix 1 details financial progress on the Capital Programme as at 30th November 2021.
- **2.2** For all schemes where it is evident that the full year's budget will not be spent during the year, the relevant officers are required to provide an explanation for the shortfall, and this shall be taken to the earliest available Cabinet.

Learning and Skills

- 2.3 Cogan Primary Replacement Shelters and Viking Boat Cogan Primary School are replacing two outdoor shelters and purchasing a role play Viking boat at a cost of £13,138. Emergency powers have been used to include this new scheme into the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a revenue contribution from the school.
- **2.4** Band B Barry Waterfront The Consortium has requested additional funding in order to enter into a contract with the contractor in order that construction can commence on site.
- 2.5 Due to the project delays, the contractor has requested additional inflationary costs to account for market conditions. Following market testing of construction packages, the contractor has requested an additional £560k to deliver the scheme. On 12 October 2021, using the emergency powers procedure, the Managing Director approved advising the Consortium that they would be liable for 50% of these costs and requesting the remaining 50% from Welsh Government. The Consortium has agreed in principle to funding 50% of the additional costs and a letter has been sent to Welsh Government to request the additional funding. However, waiting for a response could further delay this scheme.
- 2.6 To ensure the scheme wasn't delayed emergency powers have been used to carry forward £280k of the 'Band B Contingency' budget and allocate it to the Barry Waterfront scheme in the 2022/23 capital programme. If Welsh Government agrees to fund the additional costs, then the £280k would be returned to the 'Band B Contingency. The emergency powers also approved the increase in the 'S106 Developer Contribution' by £280k in the 2022/23 capital programme, which would be funded directly by the Consortium, as a requirement of their obligation within the S106 agreement. Further details can be found within the emergency powers.
- 2.7 All Saints Church in Wales Primary School Fence The school requires a new fence to secure the area to one side of the playground which adjoins open land accessible to the community. To enable this scheme to progress as soon as possible, emergency powers have been approved to include a new scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme with a budget of £18,880, to be funded (85%)

£16,048 grant from the Diocese and (15%) £2,832 virement from the All Schools Security scheme budget.

- **2.8** Old Hall Cowbridge, Renewal of roof coverings This scheme has been delayed due to resource constraints and listed building consent requirements. Works are now programmed to be carried out during the summer to suit the nature of the work. It is requested to carry forward £250k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.9 Llansannor Extension Options for this scheme are being considered and will be influenced by the outcome of the condition survey which is awaited. The scheme will not commence until next financial year, it is therefore requested to carry forward £157k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.10** St Brides The contractor is unable to start on site until April, it is therefore requested to carry forward £177k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.11** Jenner Park Primary Boiler Renewal This scheme is complete and the remaining budget is £19k. It is requested to vire this budget to the Education Asset Renewal Contingency scheme budget in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.
- 2.12 Big Bocs Bwyd Project Phase 2 The Council has been awarded £587,500 capital funding to support the establishment of the 25 additional Big Bocs Bwyd projects during phase 2 only, in schools across 9 South Wales Local Authorities. Further to the success of the scheme at Oakfield Primary, the school is leading on this project, the grant will buy containers for schools in the valleys to distribute food for deprived families. The funding relates to the period December 2021 to March 2022. It is requested to include this scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a grant from Welsh Government.
- 2.13 Oakfield Primary School Log Cabin Scheme Oakfield Primary have purchased two cabins, one of the cabins is a woodland lodge, which is used as part of the forest schools learning environment, the other is an additional space used for the community and multi-agency interventions such as parenting programmes, family support meetings, multi-agency meeting, young carers etc. It is requested to include this new scheme with a budget of £10,580 in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a revenue contribution from the school.
- 2.14 Dinas Powys Primary Tarmac Playground Further resurfacing works were carried out at Dinas Powys Primary school as a cost of £11k. It is therefore requested to increase this scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme by £11k to be funded a revenue contribution from the school.
- 2.15 Albert Primary new classroom block Due to the current economic climate the cots for this scheme have increased by a further £7k. It is requested to vire £7k from the Education Asset Renewal Contingency budget to this scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.

2.16 Ysgol Y Draig Outdoor Classroom Facility - The cost of the scheme was anticipated to be £13k however the final outturn was £17k. This scheme is funded from the WLGA Education grant from Welsh Government, the purpose of the funding is to support all schools and settings to put in place mitigating measures for ensuring their school environments are as COVID-19-safe as possible. It is requested to increase this scheme budget by £4k to be funded from the WLGA Education grant.

Social Services

2.17 Gibbonsdown, Skomer Road Flying Start Extension - The Council has received an additional £12k of grant funding from Welsh Government relating to Flying Start Capital 2021/22. The funding is for the Skomer Road Flying Start Extension scheme, as a result of additional costs which have arisen because of the current economic climate. Emergency powers has been used to increase this scheme budget by £12k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.

Environment & Housing

- 2.18 Dinas Powys Flood Resilience Project The Council has been awarded a capital grant from Welsh Government of £140,500 in relation to the Dinas Powys Property Flood Resilience project. The funding relates to the period 16/11/2021 to 16/03/2022. The purpose of the funding is to enable the Council to undertake a Business Justification Case to consider a Property Flood Resilience project for up to 244 properties within the village of Dinas Powys. Emergency powers have been used to include a new scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme funded by a grant from Welsh Government.
- 2.19 Neighbourhood Services Highway Improvements Emergency powers have been used to request to increase the 2021/22 Capital Programme by £340k to be funded by a revenue contribution from the Policy budget. The Highways Resurfacing budget has overspent this financial year by £340k due to emerging resurfacing requirements in year. Further details can be found in the emergency powers form.
- **2.20** All Wales Play Opportunities Grant 2021/22 The Council has received an award of funding of £223,000 (Capital) in relation to the All Wales Play Opportunities Grant 2021/22. The purpose of the capital funding is to provide better play opportunities for children and communities and to realise the benefits this brings in terms of child development and activity levels. It must support actions within the Council's 2021/2022 Play Sufficiency Action Plan. The capital funding can also be used to complement play work provision. Anticipated areas of spend include the following, which fall within the remit set by Welsh Government for this funding stream; purchase of a play van and wrapping of play trailer, portable floodlights, equipment and wet weather gear to support outdoor play, shipping containers to store equipment and fixed play equipment. Emergency powers

have been used to include this scheme within the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a grant from Welsh Government.

- **2.21** Resource Recovery Facility/ Waste Transfer Station Construction of the Waste transfer Station is progressing however the build will not be complete by the end of the financial year. It is requested to carry forward £3.615m into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.22 Circular Economy Sorting Equipment and Baler This scheme is to purchase mechanical sorting equipment within the proposed Resource Recovery Facility that will prepare for resale and reuse domestic kerbside recycling as part of the Council's commitment to the recycling and waste changes. The contractor appointed and the Council are in the process of agreeing specification. The majority of this budget will not be spent until the Waste Transfer Station build had significantly progressed as this is where the equipment will be housed. It is requested to carry forward £370k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.23** New Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) The Council is currently in negotiations regarding the purchase of land; therefore, the full budget will not be spent this financial year and it is requested to carry forward £1.605m into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.24** Rhoose Sustainable Transport This scheme is anticipated to be over budget and options for sources of funding are currently being looked into, with spend this financial year estimated to be £80k. It is requested to carry forward £409k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.25** Eastern Shelter Resurface Roof The remaining budget is insufficient for the repairs required. A capital bid has been submitted and internal discussion are being carried out regarding this scheme. It is requested to carry forward £73k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.26** Romilly Tennis Courts The works are anticipated to start in March 2022 for 10 weeks and will therefore not be completed by the end of the financial year. It is requested to carry forward £119k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.27 Play Area in Stanwell This scheme is currently out to consultation. It is anticipated the works will go out to tender in March/April 2022 and start on site in June. It is therefore requested to carry forward £110k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.28** Gladstone Park Interpretation Scheme It is requested to carry forward the £23k budget for this scheme into the 2022/23 Capital Programme. Due to workload pressures the team have been unable to progress this scheme this financial year.

- **2.29** Barry Leisure Centre Hall Floor This scheme is complete and there is £14k budget remaining. It is requested to vire £14k to the Leisure Centre Works scheme (contingency budget) in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.
- 2.30 Road Safety Audits Stage 4 & 5 for Cardiff Road, Dinas Powys and Floodgate Roundabout - The Council has received a £3k award of funding in relation to this scheme. It is requested to include this scheme into the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a grant from Welsh Government.
- 2.31 HRA New Build Cwrt St Cyres scheme has been let but has been delayed because of uncharted below ground services. This scheme will now continue into 2022/23. Colcot Clinic scheme is in the Planning stage and was delayed because of other scheme priorities. This scheme will continue into 2022/23. Hayes Wood Road tender has been accepted. This scheme was delayed because of issues in completing the land acquisition with Welsh Government. This scheme will continue into 2022/23. It is therefore requested that £663k is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.32** HRA Internal Works Due to delays in the procurement process for the framework the internal works programme has been on hold, with only voids and emergency works being completed. It is therefore requested that £655k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.33 HRA External Works Airey's refurbishment scheme is delayed due to higher tender prices and works are being undertaken to deliver a viable scheme. There are delays in the delivery of the window and doors contract with an estimated start date being the end of February 2022. Sewage treatment works are estimated to start in February 2022 pending consultation. It is therefore requested that £1.350m is carried forward into 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.34 Individual Schemes Section 20 EWI is now expected on site early February 2022. The Long Meadow contract was let in August 2021 but due to Ecology Survey Identifying bat's, the contract has been delayed until a license to proceed is obtained. The Severn Avenue contract was approved in August 2021, but the contractor has increased costs and therefore further procurement is required. The Pontalun scheme is being retendered due to high tender prices received but will commence in 2022/23. It is therefore requested that £2.793m is carried forward into 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.35 Common Parts Due to staff turnover there have been slight delays in the Lot 1 & 2 delivery which will now continue into 2022/23 and the delivery of the External Communal refurbishment schemes has also been delayed and will continue into 2022/23. It is therefore requested that £1.850m is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.36** Environmental Works Due to staff turnover the delivery of the Williams Irving and Owen scheme has been delayed and will continue into 2022/23. Due to the

delay in contractors not bidding for the Awbery House scheme the works will now commence in 2022/23. Buttrills environmental works are due to commence February 2022 with the majority of works being completed in 2022/23. It is therefore requested that £1.350m is carried forward into 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.37 Energy Efficiency - There have been delays due to Contractor timescales to mobilise. EWI houses are expected to commence work in January 2022 and EWI blocks of flats works are expected to commence in February 2022. It is requested that £3m is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

Managing Director and Resources

- 2.38 Barry Wayfinding Project Delegated authority has been used to repurpose the £133k unallocated Tackling Poverty Holton Road Grant Programme budget to be used for the Barry Wayfinding Project. The proposal is to be split into two stages. Stage 1 requires consultancy services to provide a wayfinding scoping report for Barry. With an emphasis on the Town Centre and its immediate vicinity, the report will contain an analysis of the current provision and make recommendations for a new wayfinding system to improve footfall and ensure residents and visitors become fully aware of all that is on offer in Barry. Stage 2 of the project will focus on delivering a phased programme of new infrastructure to supplement the Stage 1 approach.
- **2.39** WLGA Food Poverty Grant The current budget for the Penarth Food Pod scheme is £26k, however £22k additional budget is required. Emergency powers have been used to request to vire £22k from the WLGA Food Poverty Grant scheme to the Penarth Food Pod scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.
- 2.40 Central Promenade Café, Barry Island Extensive roof defects costing £50k were identified by a structural survey carried out on Central Promenade Café. A temporary repair has been carried out in order to mitigate imminent failure but the roof covering needs to be stripped off and the roof structure made safe. The cost of this cannot be covered by the annual maintenance budget for the shops. This is being carried out because the Council has an obligation as landlord under the lease to keep the exterior of the property in repair. Emergency powers have been used to include this new scheme with a budget of £50k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by the Miscellaneous Buildings reserve.
- **2.41** Five Mile Lane Completion of a culvert was to be carried out 2021/22 financial year but is behind programme and awaiting completion of the design. It is requested to carry forward £1m into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.42** Belle Vue Pavilion in Penarth This scheme is out to tender and scheduled to start on site in March 2022 and will continue into the next financial year. It is requested to carry forward £1.025m into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

- **2.43** Windmill Lane Play Area This scheme will be out to tender imminently and is anticipated to start on site in May 2022 and complete in July. It is therefore requested to carry forward £57k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.44 Civic Offices Electric Scheme This scheme is complete and has a remaining budget of £63k. It is therefore requested that £63k is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme and vired to the All Services Asset Renewal scheme.
- 2.45 Alps Depot Toilet Refurbishment A condition survey has been carried out which is currently being reviewed. Works will not be carried out this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £189k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme as part of this report.
- 2.46 BSC2 This scheme is in pre application stage, with planning consulting on design. The scheme is anticipated to go out to tender in the new year, with works commencing next financial year. It is therefore requested to carry forward £589k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.47 Penarth Renewal Area It is requested to carry forward £5k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme to allow adequate time for all parties to accept terms and enter into a final agreement prior to the commencement of works.
- 2.48 Disabled Facilities Grant Due to the COVID 19 pandemic and the availability of contractors who are on the framework, the full budget will not be spent this financial year. The increase in costs has also made it prohibitive for the contractors to deliver as part of the framework but work is currently underway to assess uplifts. It is requested to carry forward £396k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

3. How do proposals evidence the Five Ways of Working and contribute to our Well-being Objectives?

- **3.1** The Capital Programme focuses capital investment to deliver the outcomes identified as part of the Corporate Plan. Some examples are :-
- **To work with and for our communities** Consultations are carried out with the community on capital projects e.g. Band B and park schemes. Building Stronger Communities capital grants are being issued to support projects being carried out by members of the community.
- To support learning, employment and sustainable economic growth Further investment in schools through the School Investment Programme with Band A complete and development under Band B which commenced in 2019/20. Contributing as a partner in the Cardiff Capital Region City Deal will bring

economic prosperity to the area. There will be continued investment in environment and regeneration programmes to support economic growth.

- To support people at home and in their community Investment in housing through the Housing Improvement Programme will maintain the Welsh Housing Quality Standard and there is a new build programme. Disabled Facility Grants are also issued to residents. Investment in leisure centres and playgrounds will encourage more use and activity. The core active travel fund allocation grant from Welsh Government is used to implement active travel schemes.
- To respect, enhance and enjoy our environment In response to the climate emergency, the Council launched a project to explore how construction practices could be adapted to support decarbonisation as part the 21st Century Schools Programme. St David's CIW Primary School was designed to be low (in-use) carbon through improved building fabric, maximising renewables and its only energy source is electric. This model was further developed to deliver net-zero (in-use) carbon school buildings for South Point Primary School and St Nicholas CIW Primary School. The South Point Primary School scheme is due to be completed early 2022 which will make it the first net-zero carbon primary school building in Wales. Investing in the introduction of LED street lighting will bring environmental benefits. Funding has been made available for the installation of vehicle charging infrastructure and for the purchase of electric pool cars. The school decarbonisation programme consists of a variety of energy reduction measures and renewable energy installations have been identified across a number of assets within the school portfolio. Recycling is now to be sorted into separate containers, the change is aimed at improving the quality of the materials that are collected for recycling which is better for the environment and will help the Council to recycle more.
- **3.2** The setting and the monitoring of the Capital programme follows the Five Ways of Working.
- **3.3** Looking to the long term The development of the capital programme is a means of planning for the future and takes a strategic approach to ensure services are sustainable and that investments are affordable over the longer term and that future need and demand for services is understood.
- **3.4** Taking an integrated approach In setting the capital programme, working with partners is encouraged, as it allows the utilisation of funding from various sources, such as Welsh Government and S106 contributions, to deliver schemes.
- **3.5** Involving the population in decisions As part of the annual budget setting process there is engagement with residents, customers and partners. Prior to the implementation of certain capital schemes, consultation may also take place with the public which may in some cases be statutory.
- **3.6** Working in a collaborative way It is recognised that more can be achieved and better services can be provided by collaboration and it encourages this as a way of working in the future which includes providing funding to work with local communities.

3.7 Understanding the root cause of issues and preventing them – The process for setting and monitoring the capital programme is proactive and allows an understanding of the financial and operational issues to be considered together so that issues can be tackled at the source.

4. Resources and Legal Considerations

Financial

4.1 Included in this report is a request to carry forward budget of £11.661m into 2022/23 which relates to the Housing Improvement Programme which is ringfenced within the Housing Revenue Account (HRA). This is a result, in part, due to problems in the supply chain and an increase in the cost of materials. Any further lockdown restrictions could also have an impact on the level of expenditure. This will result in the budget being reduced to £19.805m. The implications of this are that there will no longer be a requirement to raise unsupported loans to fund capital expenditure this financial year and the level of revenue contributions to capital will reduce from £18.786m to £14.723m.

Employment

4.2 Some of the work included in the capital programme will be undertaken by Council staff and the relevant costs will be recharged to the capital scheme.

Legal (Including Equalities)

4.3 There are no legal implications.
