"C839 CAPITAL MONITORING FOR THE PERIOD 1ST APRIL 2021 TO 31ST JANUARY 2022 (EL/PR) (SCRUTINY – CORPORATE PERFORMANCE AND RESOURCES) -

The purpose of the report was to advise Cabinet of the progress on the 2021/22 Capital Programme for the period 1st April, 2021 to 31st January, 2022 and to request changes to the Capital Programme.

The report provided an update on the progress of the Capital Programme for the period 1st April, 2021 to 31st January, 2022. Details by scheme were shown in Appendix 1 to the report. The report also set out requested changes to the 2021/22 and future years Capital Programme.

The Deputy Leader commented that work to schools happens in school holidays and any works carried out during the Easter holidays often falls within the next financial year. Such works also demonstrate a commitment not only in terms of the building of new schools but also making sure that existing schools are maintained.

This was a matter for Executive decision.

1. Background

1.1 Council on 10th March 2021 (minute no 471) approved the Capital Programme for 2021/22 onwards.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

- **2.1** Appendix 1 details financial progress on the Capital Programme as at 31st January 2022.
- 2.2 For all schemes where it is evident that the full year's budget will not be spent during the year, the relevant officers are required to provide an explanation for the shortfall, and this shall be taken to the earliest available Cabinet.

Learning and Skills

- 2.3 Romilly Primary School Flooring New flooring is required in Romilly Primary School canteen area for health and safety reasons. The cost of the works is anticipated to be £14k. The Education Contingency budget is currently unallocated. So that this scheme can progress in February half term, delegated authority has been used to vire £14k from the Education Asset Renewal Contingency budget, to the 'Romilly Primary School Canteen Flooring' scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.
- Ysgol Sant Curig All Weather Football Pitch Ysgol Sant Curig are installing an outdoor all-weather football pitch in the school grounds. The total cost of the works is £23,532 and it is anticipated the works will be carried out in February half term. Emergency powers have been used to include this scheme into the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a revenue contribution from the school.
- 2.5 Ysgol Bro Morgannwg Water Heater One of the large water heaters at the school was found to be leaking and needed replacing. The total cost of the works was £10,314. This is classed as capital expenditure and emergency powers have been used to include this scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme, to be funded by a revenue contribution from the school.
- 2.6 Band B Programme Costs have increased within the St David's Primary School scheme and the Primary Provision in the Western Vale scheme. Both projects included a contingency amount to address unforeseen costs and the potential increase in market values as the project progresses. However, for both projects the additional costs have increased beyond the contingencies within the budget. Regarding the St. David's Primary School project, the main increase relates to implementing the drainage scheme as during construction it was found that the majority of the phase 2 area contained significant amounts of rock which needed to be removed. In terms of Llancarfan Primary School (Primary Provision in the Western Vale scheme), the cost increase predominately relates to the need to

re-level the site following the transfer of the land from Taylor Wimpey to the Council. Following a review of the programme, Whitmore High School and Ysgol Bro Morgannwg were identified as having surplus funding. These projects are in the last stages of development with the outstanding work already committed. Emergency powers have been used to vire surplus funds from Ysgol Bro Morgannwg (£103,827) and Whitmore High School (£166,203) to the Saint David's Primary School scheme (£132,890) and the Primary Provision in the Western Vale scheme (£137,140).

Various Education Schemes - Within the Learning and Skills capital programme a number of schemes have slightly overspent and a number of schemes have slightly underspent the original estimates. The table below provides the details by schemes:-

The total overspend to be funded is £6.5k and it is proposed that this is vired from the Education Contingency scheme budget. Emergency powers have been used to amend the approved budgets as set out in the table above by viring budgets between the schemes and also viring £6.5k from the Education Contingency scheme.

2.8 Schools Decarbonisation Programme Photo Voltaic (PV) Panels - PV panels are being installed in three school, Evenlode Primary School, Llansannor Primary School and Ysgol Gwaun Y Nant. The PV systems installed to date on other

buildings have been proven to be reliable generators of renewable electricity and are a proven technology towards the Council's net zero goal. The works are currently out to tender and it is anticipated that works will start on site in March and will be completed by the end of March. The total cost is anticipated to be £85k. It is requested to include this scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded £69k from the Salix recyclable fund in the Energy Management reserve and £17k revenue contribution from the Carbon Reduction Commitment Legacy budget.

- 2.10 All Schools Condition Surveys The condition surveys are progressing and anticipated to be completed by the end of March. The estimated budget required this financial year is £88k and it is requested to carry forward £62k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme to be able to carry out suitability surveys of the school in the next financial year.
- 2.11 All Schools Covid Response Works The condition surveys will not be completed until mid-March which will then enable the Council to complete the assessment of priority spend. It is therefore requested to carry forward £80k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme and to vire to the All Schools Condition Survey Urgent Works Arising scheme budget.
- 2.12 All Schools Condition Survey Urgent Works Arising The condition surveys will not be completed until mid-March which will then enable the Council to complete the assessment of priority spend. It is therefore requested to carry forward £130k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.13 Albert Primary External Repairs (Stores) Work at Albert Primary School are to be reprioritised as it has now been identified that separate works to the boundary wall may also be required. The schemes will be prioritised following the condition survey report and the outcome of boundary wall requirements. It is requested to carry forward £45k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.14 Albert Primary Replacement windows / wet rot Work at Albert Primary School are to be reprioritised as it has now been identified that separate works to the boundary wall may also be required. The schemes will be prioritised following the condition survey report and the outcome of boundary wall requirements. It is requested to carry forward £40k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.15 Holton Primary Drainage Repairs Works are to be reassessed following the outcome of the condition survey report. It is requested to carry forward £50k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.16** Holton Primary Window Replacement & Remedial Wall Ties Works are to be reassessed following the outcome of the condition survey report. It is requested to carry forward £20k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.17 Rhws Primary Windows Refurbishment Phase 5 This scheme is not yet programmed as Property are awaiting the outcome of the condition survey. It is requested to carry forward £30k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

- 2.18 Albert Primary External Repairs Work at Albert Primary School are to be reprioritised as it has now been identified that separate works to the boundary wall may also be required. The schemes will be prioritised following the condition survey report and the outcome of boundary wall requirements. It is requested to carry forward £20k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.19 St Illtyd's Primary Fire Precaution Works This work is yet to be programmed and it is therefore requested to carry forward £17k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.20** Wick & Marcross Primary Rewire This scheme will be going out to tender in February and works are anticipated to start in April. It is therefore requested to carry forward £60k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.21** Peterston Super Ely Primary Suspended Ceiling Renewal Phase 1 This scheme is due to go out to tender in February and therefore works will not be carried out this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £74k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.22 Ysgol Sant Curig Boiler Renewal The boiler scheme at Ysgol Sant Curig had some complications as it is a Victorian school heating system and additional pipework was needed along with more reactive work to bleeding/filling and commissioning the system due to its size and complexity. This resulted in an overspend of £18k. The Romilly Primary KS2 Boiler Renewal scheme is underspent, and it is therefore requested to vire £18k from the Romilly Primary KS2 Boiler Renewal scheme to the Ysgol Sant Curig Boiler Renewal scheme.
- 2.23 Education Asset Renewal Contingency This budget is currently unallocated and is predominantly used if emergency schemes arise. It is requested to carry forward £170k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme for schemes to be allocated as required next financial year.
- 2.24 St Illtyd's Primary Doors This is scheme is anticipated to be carried out in the first quarter of next financial year. It is requested to carry forward £38k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.25 Wick & Marcross Primary Internal Alterations This scheme is going out to tender in February and works are anticipated to start in April. It is requested to carry forward £140k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.26 Ysgol Sant Curig Security Lobby This scheme is going out to tender in February and therefore works will not commence this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £54k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.27 St Richard Gwyn Ventilation Scheme It is requested to include a new scheme with a budget of £14k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to fund window openings with extending arms to existing windows in the English block to

- increase ventilation. This scheme will be funded from the Welsh Government ventilation in education settings grant.
- 2.28 Llansannor Primary WC Refurbishment Works are to be reassessed following the outcome of the condition survey report. It is requested to carry forward £60k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.29** Band B Primary Provision in the Western Vale The school being constructed with this budget is to be called South Point Primary School, it is therefore requested to change the name of the scheme in the Capital Programme to Band B South Point Primary School.
- 2.30 Ysgol Y Deri Minibus The school have recently purchased another minibus for £20k, replacing a bus that has been removed from service. It is requested to increase this scheme budget by £20k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a revenue contribution from the school.

Social Services

- 2.31 Flying Start Skomer Road Crèche The Council has been awarded a variation to the Flying Start Capital Grant 2021/22. The award is for £30k to complete the additional work required at Grasshopper Creche (formally Skomer Road Creche). This additional funding must be claimed in full by 31 March 2022. This scheme is currently progressing and is anticipated to be complete by the end of March 2022. Emergency powers have been used to increase this budget by £30k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded from Welsh Government grant.
- 2.32 Salisbury Road No. 91 (YOS) External Repairs Phase 2 Further work is being undertaken to confirm the details of the required works, therefore this budget will not be spent this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £15k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.33 Flying Start Skomer Road Crèche It is requested to change the name of this scheme to Crèche and Community Enterprise Centre building works. This scheme is funded from £75k Flying Start grant and £40k internal monies. The crèche works are anticipated to be able to be funded from the grant element however additional works are required to the Community Enterprise Centre building and the remainder of the internal monies will be used for these works.

Environment & Housing

2.34 Caerleon Road Footpath - The Council has agreed to implement a new pathway on Caerleon Road, to access a new play area being installed. Delegated authority has been used to include this scheme in the Capital Programme with a budget of £2,000 in 2021/22, and £122,411 in 2022/23 to be funded using \$106 monies for sustainable transport.

2.35 All Wales Play Opportunity Grant 2021/22 - Two new outdoor structures are being installed at Ysgol Gymraeg Dewi Sant. The school is keen to enhance provision for outdoor learning and extended play, providing opportunities for pupils to learn and explore in their outdoor spaces. Having both structures implemented on the school site will greatly increase the school's provision for outdoor education. It is anticipated that the structures will enhance the outdoor spaces available to the school and will provide a rich and nurturing environment. They will also help promote creativity. The outdoor classrooms will be the school's first steps in their longer-term plan to develop a garden and forest school area.

The outdoor classrooms will mainly be used by pupils at Ysgol Gymraeg Dewi Sant. It will also be used to develop community links with pupils from Cylch Meithrin Llanilltud Fawr who will be sharing the school site at the end of January 2022. The school also intends to strengthen links with the local secondary school and primary schools where the classrooms can be used to facilitate different shared activities. The scheme is anticipated to cost £26,300. This is being funded from a £15,300 contribution from the All Wales Play Opportunities grant which is already approved in the Capital Programme, the remaining £11k is being funded by a contribution from the school budget. Emergency powers have been used to increase the All Wales Play Opportunities Grant 2021/22 scheme budget by £11k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.

- 2.36 Penarth Marina Land Slip Works In order to complete phase 1, a further £32,415 is required for the car parks works. This quote includes for the replacement of 250m of fencing including new posts, removal of all materials from the ditch and repairs to the existing rock netting including taking down and replacing the close boarded fencing to the Dock car park. Due to the urgent nature of the works emergency powers have been used to increase the Penarth Marina Land Slip Works budget by £32,415 in the 2021/22 Capital Programme which is to be funded by a contribution from the Policy revenue budget.
- 2.37 Metro Enhanced Framework (MEF) Scheme The Council has been awarded a grant of £100k for the Vale of Glamorgan MEF scheme from the Metro Plus Programme 2021/22 through Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council. This funding is to carry out a WelTAG 1 Study. The primary purpose of the WelTAG 1 is to set out the case for change (Strategic case) for the priority corridors, identify the key strategic journeys within the study area, identify a short list of options for priority corridors. The expected outcome is a recommendation of short-listed option/s or packages of options to be taken forward to WelTAG 2 leading to the delivery of infrastructure improvements. Emergency powers have been used to include this scheme onto the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded from the grant detailed above.
- 2.38 Neighbourhood Services Highway Improvements The Council has been awarded additional general capital grant in 2021/22 of £2,702,921. This funding is unhypothecated to give authorities the maximum flexibility however the award

letter does state that one area that local authorities have specifically highlighted as an area of pressure is the maintenance of the existing highways network. Emergency powers have been used to increase the Neighbourhood Services Highway Improvements scheme budget by £500k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded from additional general capital funding. The remainder of the additional general capital funding will be allocated as part of the Final Capital Proposals report which is on the same agenda as this report.

- 2.39 Penarth Leisure Centre, High Level Glazing This scheme has required further analysis on the cost and the scope of the work, and this is still on-going, therefore these works will not be carried out this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £170k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- **2.40** Barry Leisure Centre Boiler Renewal This scheme is anticipated to go out to tender in February, therefore works will not commence this financial year. It is requested to carry forward £155k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.41 New Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) The land purchase will not be complete by the end of the financial year as land negotiations are on-going and there is a need for planning permission. It is requested to carry forward £350k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.42 Barry Island On-Street Parking Restrictions It is requested to include a budget of £35k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme for on street parking restrictions at Barry Island. This work has already been completed however should be classified as capital. This scheme is to be funded by a revenue contribution from the Highways budget.
- 2.43 Vehicles Renewal Fund It is requested to bring forward £196k from the 2022/23 Capital Programme into the 2021/22 Capital Programme. The Council have been able to take early delivery of stock. With shortages and delays in delivery it is prudent that this is undertaken to allow older vehicles/plant to be replaced.
- 2.44 Dinas Powys Sustainable Transport Works will be undertaken following the demobilisation of the developer on site. This work will not be carried out in 2022/23, it is therefore requested to carry forward £191k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.45 Ty lolo Hostel Lift installation Following routine maintenance of the lift at Ty lolo Hostel there were major repairs identified which resulted in the lift being beyond economical repair. An emergency replacement lift was installed. It is therefore requested to vire £20k from the Emergency works scheme to this new scheme in the 2021/22 Capital Programme.
- 2.46 HRA New Build Due to delays in acquisitions the schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £1.250m be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

- 2.47 HRA Internal Works Accessing properties has caused delays along with the procurement of the framework. The schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £250k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.48 HRA External Works Due to delays with the contractor starting on site, which is now March 2022, the delivery of the schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £354k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.49 Individual Schemes Increases in the contract price, contractor's timescale to mobilise and issues with obtaining a bat licence led to delays with the contractor starting on site, which is now March 2022, thus the schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £124k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.50 Common Parts Due to staff turnover, there are delays in delivery and the contractor is expected to start on site in April 2022 therefore the schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £641k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.51 Emergency Works Due to the level of works required and the estimated cost, this project has been put on hold pending a viability assessment and therefore the scheme has been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £81k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.52 IHP- Heating retrofit Due to properties that have been identified as no longer being appropriate and access issues, there are delays in delivery. This scheme has been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £100k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.53 Environmental Works Due to staff turnover the delivery of Williams Irving and Owen scheme has been delayed and will now start on site March 2022. Due to delay in contractors not bidding for the Awbery House scheme the works will now commence June 2022. Buttrills environmental works are due to commence in February 2022 with the majority of works being completed in 2022/23. These schemes have now been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £1.397m be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.54 Energy Efficiency Due to staff turnover and delays in the contractor starting on site the start date is now March 2022, thus the schemes have been reprofiled. It is therefore requested that £965k be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

Managing Director and Resources

- 2.55 Building Strong Communities Fund The Council has agreed to issue a grant to Rhoose Community Library towards an extension at Rhoose Library, equalling £203k. Work has commenced on site, and draw down is anticipated imminently. The project is to build an L-shape extension to the current Rhoose Community Library building for the purpose of flexible meeting/training spaces for community use. Delegated authority has been used to increase the Capital Programme by £203k in 2021/22, using £180k S106 monies received from a nearby development and £23k Stronger Communities revenue budget.
- 2.56 Building Strong Communities Fund Community facility at St Paul's Church Penarth The Council has agreed to issue Newydd Housing Association a grant of £400k towards the new community centre which has been built as part of the St. Pauls Affordable Housing scheme. Delegated authority has been used to increase the 2021/22 Capital Programme by £400k to be funded from s106 monies.
- 2.57 Community Renewal Fund Barry Bands Together The Council has been awarded an £11k capital grant for Barry Bands Together Community Regeneration through Musical Partnership. This will be paid out as a grant to Cardiff County and the Vale of Glamorgan Music Service. The grant is to refurbish the Vale of Glamorgan brass band premises as the music hub for the community. Emergency powers have been used to include this new scheme into the 2021/22 Capital Programme to be funded by a grant from the UK Government.
- 2.58 Local Nature Partnership Grant Further funding of £45k has been awarded to the Council due to an underspend in the Welsh Government grant allocation and organisations were asked to submit proposals for further capital purchases / projects. After consultation with officers in relation to the biodiversity projects undertaken annually, it was decided that the purchase of a remote controlled mower would be beneficial, as it would enable steep sided banks normally inaccessible to be maintained and managed for the benefit of biodiversity improvement. Emergency powers have been used to increase this scheme budget by £45k in the 2021/22 Capital Programme which will be funded by a grant from Welsh Government.
- 2.59 Murch Community Sports Facilities The Council has agreed to upgrade and transform the two outdoor sports courts currently adjacent to the Murchfield Community Centre. They are in a state of disrepair and given the relationship with the play area, community centre and primary school, the site presents real opportunity to create an outdoor recreational space, whilst also providing outdoor sports facilities. Delegated authority has been used to increase the Capital Programme by £12k in 2021/22, and £185k in 2022/23, (£197k in total) using Section 106 monies received from the Former St Cyres Lower School,

Murch Road, Dinas Powys, to provide/improve Public Open Space and for Public Art.

- 2.60 Cosmeston Works Programme No tenders were returned for this scheme; therefore, the works will not progress this financial year. It is anticipated that this scheme will go back out to tender in the new financial year. It is requested to carry forward £120k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.61 Central Promenade Café Roof, Barry Island The work was anticipated to commence in January however having inspected the roof space in more detail it has been concluded that this work would require full access to the building and more specific design details from a structural engineer. The work will now be carried out in 2022/23. It is requested to carry forward £50k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.62 Cowbridge Livestock Market Regeneration Budget Ongoing works to the site are required next financial year, it is therefore requested to carry forward £22k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.63 Penarth Heights Public Art A contractor has been appointed for the historic shelter scheme and consultation is underway. The scheme will continue into 2022/23 and it is therefore requested to carry forward £80k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.64 Ventilation & Lighting Upgrade to Contact One Vale This scheme has not been able to commence this financial year due to resource pressures and works will now be programmed in the next financial year. It is requested to carry forward £240k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.65 ICT Allocation This budget is unallocated and is expected to be used for ICT projects next financial year. It is therefore requested to carry forward £47k into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

3. How do proposals evidence the Five Ways of Working and contribute to our Well-being Objectives?

3.1 The Capital Programme focuses capital investment to deliver the outcomes identified as part of the Corporate Plan. Some examples are :-

- To work with and for our communities Consultations are carried out with the community on capital projects e.g. Band B and park schemes. Building Stronger Communities capital grants are being issued to support projects being carried out by members of the community.
- To support learning, employment and sustainable economic growth Further investment in schools through the School Investment Programme with Band A complete and development under Band B which commenced in 2019/20. Contributing as a partner in the Cardiff Capital Region City Deal will bring economic prosperity to the area. There will be continued investment in environment and regeneration programmes to support economic growth.
- To support people at home and in their community Investment in housing through the Housing Improvement Programme will maintain the Welsh Housing Quality Standard and there is a new build programme. Disabled Facility Grants are also issued to residents. Investment in leisure centres and playgrounds will encourage more use and activity. The core active travel fund allocation grant from Welsh Government is used to implement active travel schemes.
- To respect, enhance and enjoy our environment In response to the climate emergency, the Council launched a project to explore how construction practices could be adapted to support decarbonisation as part the 21st Century Schools Programme. St David's CIW Primary School was designed to be low (in-use) carbon through improved building fabric, maximising renewables and its only energy source is electric. This model was further developed to deliver net-zero (in-use) carbon school buildings for South Point Primary School and St Nicholas CIW Primary School. The South Point Primary School scheme is due to be completed February 2022 which will make it the first net-zero carbon primary school building in Wales. Investing in the introduction of LED street lighting will bring environmental benefits. Funding has been made available for the installation of vehicle charging infrastructure and for the purchase of electric pool cars. The school decarbonisation programme consists of a variety of energy reduction measures and renewable energy installations have been identified across a number of assets within the school portfolio. Recycling is now to be sorted into separate containers, the change is aimed at improving the quality of the materials that are collected for recycling which is better for the environment and will help the Council to recycle more.
- **3.2** The setting and the monitoring of the Capital programme follows the Five Ways of Working.
- **3.3 Looking to the long term** The development of the capital programme is a means of planning for the future and takes a strategic approach to ensure services are sustainable and that investments are affordable over the longer term and that future need and demand for services is understood.
- **Taking an integrated approach** In setting the capital programme, working with partners is encouraged, as it allows the utilisation of funding from various sources, such as Welsh Government and S106 contributions, to deliver schemes.

- 3.5 Involving the population in decisions As part of the annual budget setting process there is engagement with residents, customers and partners. Prior to the implementation of certain capital schemes, consultation may also take place with the public which may in some cases be statutory.
- **3.6 Working in a collaborative way** It is recognised that more can be achieved and better services can be provided by collaboration and it encourages this as a way of working in the future which includes providing funding to work with local communities.
- 3.7 Understanding the root cause of issues and preventing them The process for setting and monitoring the capital programme is proactive and allows an understanding of the financial and operational issues to be considered together so that issues can be tackled at the source.

4. Resources and Legal Considerations

Financial

4.1 Included in this report is a request to carry forward budget of £5.162m into 2022/23 relating to the Housing Improvement Programme which is ringfenced within the Housing Revenue Account (HRA). This is a result, in part, due to problems in the supply chain and an increase in the cost of materials. This will result in the budget being reduced to £14.643m. The implications of this are that there will no longer be a requirement to raise unsupported loans to fund capital expenditure this financial year and the level of revenue contributions to capital will reduce from £14.723m to £7.526m.

Employment

4.2 Some of the work included in the capital programme will be undertaken by Council staff and the relevant costs will be recharged to the capital scheme.

Legal (Including Equalities)

4.3 There are no legal implications.
