"C47 CAPITAL CLOSURE OF ACCOUNTS 2021/22 (EL/PR) (SCRUTINY – CORPORATE PERFORMANCE AND RESOURCES) –

The report informed Cabinet of the provisional financial position of the Council's Capital Programme for the 2021/22 financial year.

There was capital expenditure during the year of $\pounds 66.411$ M which required funding of $\pounds 1.191$ M to be drawdown from reserves.

The Leader said that the delivery of the capital programme and a spend of £66.411M was to be praised whilst emerging from the pandemic and returning to 'business as usual'. She referred to projects being delivered as part of Project Zero and commitments in the Council's Climate Challenge Plan, noting the £30m spent on the Sustainable Communities for Learning programme had delivered five new schools in the previous year and construction had commenced in the Waterfront site in January 2022, the purchase of 12 electric vehicles and £2m spent on highways resurfacing.

Schemes had been subject to delays, mainly due to the current economic climate that had increased the cost of materials and labour and led to further negotiations with contractors and project reengineering.

£1.191M had been drawn down from reserves, which was significantly less than planned due to the number of late grants received.

This was a matter for Executive decision.

- **2.** To enable the Scrutiny Committee responsible for finance to review the year end position.

1. Background

- **1.1** Following the end of the financial year, Cabinet is provided with provisional outturn figures for the Council. It is anticipated that the Statement of Accounts will be approved by Council during September 2022, which will follow the audit by Audit Wales.
- **1.2** This report is to be referred to Corporate Performance and Resources Scrutiny Committee and separate reports will be presented the other respective Scrutiny Committees.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

- **2.1** Council on 10th February, 2021 (minute no. C488) agreed the Authority's capital budget for 2021/22.
- 2.2 The COVID-19 pandemic had a varying impact on the delivery of the capital programme and a spend of £66.411M was achieved as set out in the table below. There has been a significant increase in the cost of materials and labour, this has resulted in delays to schemes where negotiations and project re-engineering has been required to bring schemes within the budget available. Sourcing materials has also been problematic with long lead times when ordering and this has also impacted on the progress of the capital programme.

- 2.3 The overall position on the revised 2021/22 Capital Programme was a variance of £13.410m against a planned programme of £79.821M. The statement at Appendix 1 details the outturn by scheme. There was slippage of £11.496M against planned programmes of work during the year and this has been brought forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme with approval via Chief Executive's Emergency Powers.
- 2.4 In 2021/22 the Council was in receipt of over 50 grant awards on the Capital Programme, many of which arrived late in the financial year. This is favourable in that it brings additional funding into the Council. However the terms and conditions of the grants can sometimes be onerous and can involve providing quarterly claims to the awarding body along with invoices and defrayment evidence.

Learning and Skills

- **2.5** The overall outturn for the Directorate of Learning and Skills is a variance of £3.653m. The major variances are outlined below.
- 2.6 Band B Barry Waterfront Slippage of £1.396M

The 2021/22 budget for the Barry Waterfront Primary School scheme was £4.564M, construction was anticipated to begin in late 2021 based upon information provided by the Consortium and their agreed contractor. However, there were several delays to the start on site date due to contractual arrangements between the contractor, the Consortium and the Council.

Following further discussions in November 2021 a way forward was agreed with the contractor starting on site in January 2022. However, no contract had been entered between the Consortium, the contractor and the Council. Instead, the works were being undertaken under a Letter of Intent. On 31st March, 2022, a Deed of Variation (DoV) was agreed and signed to the Section 106 agreement.

Although the construction works have continued on the scheme, the Consortium have yet to enter into contract with the contractor. Consequently, no payment schedule has yet been agreed with the Council to cover the costs they are responsible for. The Consortium has confirmed they are aiming to be in contract by the end of June 2022 and a draft cost schedule has been submitted to the Council on 9th June, 2022. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers to carry forward £1.396M into the 2022/23 Capital Programme

2.7 Band B Whitmore High School - Slippage of 220K

Slippage relates to delay in the £32M construction programme. External landscaping was programmed to be completed in March 2022. However due to inclement weather the outstanding works were delayed resulting in a change in the payment profile will the works were on hold. The works have now been commenced and completion is planned for June 2022. It has been requested via emergency powers to carry forward £220K into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.8 Band B Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Morgannwg – Slippage £233K

Slippage relates to ongoing snagging issues relating to the refurbishment of the school building. Although the construction of the project is complete, the Council is in discussions with the Contractor to agree the works to be covered under the works agreement. This has resulted in a delay in the payment schedule until the snagging issue is resolved. It has been requested via emergency powers to carry forward £233K into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.9 Childcare Offer Capital Grant – Variance of £442k, slippage of £290K

The variance relates to two projects within the Childcare Offer grant capital schemes, Gladstone Primary and Llanfair Primary childcare units. The works at Gladstone were delayed into April 2022 due to contractor availability. The original contractor identified to carry out the works had undertaken the drainage works to the rest of the site and was therefore most suited to undertaking the

SAB drainage requirements. However, they were unable to work on the project due to resource issues, so an alternative contractor had to be secured. The works will be completed on site mid-June. The Llanfair drainage works also slipped into 2022/23, therefore slippage of £290k has been requested to be carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme via emergency powers.

Social Services

- **2.10** The overall outturn for the Directorate of Social Services is a variance of £749K.
- 2.11 ICF 4 Carys Close Refurbishment Project— Slippage of £249K The lowest tender received was more than double the available funding. As such, the project was delayed several months due to the need for extensive value engineering of the project. Additional funding to enable the project to proceed also had to be identified from Social Services Reserves. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £249K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

Neighbourhood Services & Transport and Housing

- **2.12** The overall outturn for the Directorate of Environment and Housing is a variance of £6.886M. This comprises £4.586M for Housing Services and £2.300M for Neighbourhood Services and Transport (including Community Safety). The major variances are outlined below.
- 2.13 Coast Protection and Land Drainage Slippage of £220K

The funds identified for slippage were allocated to fund the current relining and restoration works contract. Procurement of the relining contract was delayed prior to award of the contract with the final contract sealed in June 2022 at a value of £205K. The initial cost estimates, and hence slippage, were higher than the final award figure due to the significant inflationary pressures within the construction industry around the tender period. The slippage will fund remedial works that have been identified in areas hit by flooding in December 2020. It has been requested via emergency powers to carry forward £220K into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.14 SRIC - Fairfield Primary Community Street Design Project – Variance of £239K, slippage of £138K slippage

£100K has not been claimed from Welsh Government as there have been delays in the progression of the Traffic Regulation Order which has meant construction works cannot proceed on Dryden Road. Funding has been awarded for 2022/23 that will allow the scheme to be completed. It has been requested via emergency powers to carry forward £138K into the 2022/23 Capital Programme as the Council was allowed by Welsh Government to claim for works committed prior to 31st March, 2022.

2.15 Waste Transfer Station – Overspend of £591K

As a result of amendments to the construction schedule, it was possible to commit higher value expenditure to the project, during 2021/22 than initially anticipated. The project is currently on budget and phase one is expected to be completed the end of October 2022. It has been requested via emergency powers to bring forward budget from the 2022/23 allocation to cover the overspend.

- **2.16** Housing Improvement Programme Favourable variance of £4.586M with slippage of £4.287M.
- 2.17 Welsh Housing Quality Standard (WHQS) Internal Works Central Heating and boiler replacements, Kitchen replacements and Bathrooms have underspent due to delays in the procurement of the framework because of staff turnover. The underspend of £204K will offset the overspend on IHP retro fit scheme £79K, £4k to emergency works and £25K to Jenner Walls.
- 2.18 WHQS External Works- Roof renewals £325K has been delayed due to delays in the procurement due to increased costs and staff turnover, the Aireys £95K project is to be re-evaluated in 2022/23 to ensure value for money, the windows and doors contract continues into 2022/23 requiring £34K. Sewage treatment works will continue into 2022/23 requiring £66K It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £519K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.19 Environmental Works The Buttrill's Environmental scheme ended the financial year with a £220K underspend. This is due to in part the Buttrill's Awbrey House scheme being put on hold for a large period of time. This was due to no tender bids being received on the first round of procurement and the Buttrills estate environmental improvement project start being delayed by the contractor. These works will continue to be delivered during 2022/23. Environmental Improvements Trebefad works will be completed in 2022/23.
- 2.20 Due to staffing issues within Highways, there was an impact on the delivery of the Highways maintenance & Street Lighting replacement programmes. Pathways works have been delayed due to problems in packaging the works. The Williams/Irving and Owen scheme has been delayed due to staff turnover and will continue into 2022/23. It has therefore been requested that £462K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme via emergency powers.
- **2.21** Common Parts To assist with the continuation of works to communal areas Lot 1&2 and fire safety works which were delayed due to the framework. It has

therefore been requested via emergency powers that £384K is carried forward into 2022/23.

- **2.22** IHP Retrofit- To facilitate the continuation works in 2021/22 this scheme has overspent by £79K which will be offset against the Internal works underspend.
- **2.23** Emergency Works- To assist with the continuation of emergency works projects. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £39K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme which includes the virement from internal works of £4K mentioned above.
- 2.24 Individual Schemes- S20 Leaseholder blocks, Severn Avenue and Long meadow have all been delayed due to a Contractor going into administration and a contractor delaying the delivery start date of the S20 Leaseholder blocks scheme, the works will continue into 2022/23. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £712K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.25 Energy Efficiency Street lighting was underspent £66K due to staffing issues. External Wall Insulation (EWI) was underspent £420K due to small delays in the procured schemes starting later in the year and will continue into 2022/23. Energy Efficiency will commence in 2022/23. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £479K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.
- 2.26 New Builds The Cwrt St Cyres scheme will continue into 2022/23.
 Hayes Road had some small delays around supply chain issues and will now be completed in May 2022.

Land Appropriation at Holm View Phase 2 £740K budget was allocated and was completed prior to 31st March, 2022. There is no actual expenditure against the budget, but this needed to be accounted for as there was an increase in borrowing to fund the appropriations.

Land acquisitions at Coldbrook Road East and Olive Lodge, Barry were not completed during 2021/22 and will be carried forward to 2022/23 for the acquisitions to be completed.

Barry Town gateway will continue into 2022/23.

It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £1.417M is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.27 Integrated Care Fund (ICF) Penarth Older Persons Village – This scheme will progress in 2022/23. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £275K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme to fund detailed

design and additional due diligence of the proposed Council owned over 55's accommodation.

Managing Director and Resources

- **2.28** The overall outturn for the Managing Director and Resources is a variance of £2.122M. The major variances are outlined below.
- 2.29 Court Road Relocation Slippage of £204K

The handover of Court Road Depot only occurred on 6th June, 2022 several months later than anticipated. As a result, the operational services of Parks and Cleansing were able to use the facility and work from the locality a lot longer which brought added value to local services and provide additional welfare facilities, to locally based staff. However, as this site is no longer available, there will have to be some other infrastructure investment and additional adaptions to the Alps depot to facilitate all services working from one location, as part of the Court Road closure. The remaining budget attributed to the Court Road Depot closure will be sufficient to undertake the necessary works. It has therefore been requested via emergency powers that £204K is carried forward into the 2022/23 Capital Programme.

2.30 Upgrade of backup and recovery infrastructure – Variance of £200K

The scheme spend has been transferred to the revenue budget as the majority of the scheme spend was to cover maintenance agreement costs which cannot be capitalised.

3. How do proposals evidence the Five Ways of Working and contribute to our Well-being Objectives?

3.1 The underspend on the revised capital programme in 2021/22 is £13.410M against a budget of £79.821M with actual spend of £66.411M and therefore its expenditure is incurred in order to achieve its corporate priorities as set out in the Corporate Plan 2020-2025 through the 4 well-being outcomes.

4. Climate Change and Nature Implications

- **4.1** The Council understands the importance of decarbonisation to help protect and sustain the environment over the long term and in line with its Climate emergency declaration is working and investing in measures to reduce its CO2 emissions. The projects detailed below reflect the work the Council is undertaking as part of Project Zero and commitments in the Council's Climate Challenge Plan:-
 - The Council has continued to improve the energy efficiency of its housing stock to meet the requirements of Welsh Government legislation in relation to decarbonisation and the Welsh Housing Quality Standard (WHQS).

- The Sustainable Communities for Learning programme is committed to contributing to the decarbonisation agenda. Prior to Welsh Governments declaration that all new schools would be Net Zero Carbon, the Sustainable Communities for Learning programme was delivering carbon reduction measures as part of its projects. The programme has produced a Sustainability Framework and identified key processes and enabling structures have been identified and reviewed to ensure the programme can deliver low and net zero carbon school buildings.
- PV panels are being installed in three schools, Evenlode Primary School, Llansannor Primary School and Ysgol Gwaun Y Nant. The PV systems installed to date on other buildings have been proven to be reliable generators of renewable electricity and are a proven technology towards the Council's net zero goal. PV have also been installed at Saint Brides CiW Primary school during 2021/22.
- Cadoxton Sports Hall has benefited from LED lighting and occupancy sensor control in the hall in 2021/22. This will result in reduced running costs, electricity consumption and carbon emissions.
- A grant was awarded to the Council in 2021/22 from Energy Services Wales (through Welsh Government) to cover the difference in cost between a diesel and electric vehicle. This has accelerated the transition process. The Council has purchased 12 electric vehicles which will sit within the pool car fleet. These 12 vehicles, Hyundai e-Kona's, will replace at least 12 of the current diesel vehicles. An additional usage study will determine if more diesel vehicles can be removed from the fleet in quarter one of 2022/23.
- Plans to increase the number of public electric vehicle charging points are being progressed as part of funding accessed through Cardiff Capital Region, with a number of key sites including council owned car parks being considered in a phased roll out over the next 12 months. Alongside this, work is being undertaken to establish an on-street charging policy with the assistance of an ULEV grant.
- The proposal to develop fleet parking on Atlantic Trading Estate (ATE) opposite the Council's Resource Recovery Facility (Currently under construction) will reduce the daily impact that the collection fleet has on the environment, in terms of tailpipe emissions as well as increasing the productivity of the service, giving more productive time spent kerbside collecting.
- All schemes progressed as part of the Capital Programme proposals set out the decarbonisation considerations that will be considered as part of progressing the bids.

5. Resources and Legal Considerations

Financial

- **5.1** The underspend on the revised capital programme in 2021/22 is £13.410M against a budget of £79.821M with actual spend of £66.411M.
- **5.2** The following table shows how the capital programme has been financed in 2021/22.

- 5.3 General Capital Funding Capital expenditure in the year was sufficient to cover the full allocation of the supported borrowing allocation from Welsh Government. £2.899M of the General Capital grant has been spent during 2021/22 and £539K has been carried forward into 2022/23 which is allowable in the terms and conditions of the grant. In some instances where schemes were originally planned to be financed from General Capital Funding have underspent, other schemes, planned to be funded from capital receipts, revenue contributions to capital or reserves, have been substituted in their place.
- 5.4 Capital Receipts The Council Fund capital receipts balance as at 31st March, 2022 was £16.212M which are split as follows:

- 5.5 As a result of the capital underspend in 2021/22, an allocation of £11.495M has been approved via Managing Director's Emergency Powers, as slippage into 2022/23. This will fund the completion of schemes as shown in Appendix 2. Of this figure, the sum of £520K will be funded from capital receipts and £10.975M will be provided from revenue, reserves, borrowing or external sources.
- **5.6** Housing Revenue Account £10.056M was spent on major improvements to the Council's housing stock during 2021/22. The Major Repairs Allowance (MRA) is a grant given to the Authority by the WG and can be used for capital expenditure on HRA assets. The Authority's MRA for 2021/22 was £2.770M. The following table shows a breakdown of the financing of HRA expenditure in 2021/22:-

Employment

This means that for 2021/22 the Statement of Accounts should be certified by the Section 151 Officer by 31st May, 2022.
- 5.9 If it is not possible to meet this deadline the Council has to advertise that this has not happened and the reason, why. Due to the pressures of the COVID-19 pandemic and a number of staff changes it was not possible to produce the Statement of Accounts by 31st May, 2022 and the appropriate advert was placed. The Statement of Accounts was signed by the S151 Officer by 5th July, 2022.
