<p>Details of the Prejudicial Interest</p>	<p>I have declared an interest as a person, who simply together with my husband manages an allotment number 20, part of the Treoes Allotments Group. There is an issue currently needing to be discussed and voted on between Treoes Allotments and Saron Chapel.</p> <p>At the moment I am advised I may speak but cannot vote on this matter as my interests <u>may be</u> prejudicial.</p> <p>I do not feel they are prejudicial at all, I am not part of the allotments management group, merely an allotment holder of several years. I am not in any way linked to Saron Chapel. Hence I am seeking clarity and dispensation to speak AND vote.</p>
